## The Collect of the Day

Almighty God, give us grace that we may cast away the works of darkness, and put upon us the armor of light, now in the time of this mortal life in which thy Son Jesus Christ came to visit us in great humility; that in the last day, when he shall come again in his glorious majesty to judge both the quick and the dead, we may rise to the life immortal; through him who liveth and reigneth with thee and the Holy Ghost, one God, now and forever. *Amen.*

## A Reading from the Book of Zechariah 14:1-11

Behold, a day of the LORD is coming, when the spoil taken from you will be divided in the midst of you. <sup>2</sup> For I will gather all the nations against Jerusalem to battle, and the city shall be taken and the houses plundered and the women ravished; half of the city shall go into exile, but the rest of the people shall not be cut off from the city. <sup>3</sup> Then the LORD will go forth and fight against those nations as when he fights on a day of battle. <sup>4</sup> On that day his feet shall stand on the Mount of Olives which lies before Jerusalem on the east; and the Mount of Olives shall be split in two from east to west by a very wide valley; so that one half of the Mount shall withdraw northward, and the other half southward. <sup>5</sup> And the valley of my mountains shall be stopped up, for the valley of the mountains shall touch the side of it; and you shall flee as you fled from the earthquake in the days of Uzziah king of Judah. Then the LORD your God will come, and all the holy ones with him. <sup>6</sup> On that day there shall be neither cold nor frost. <sup>7</sup> And there shall be continuous day (it is known to the LORD), not day and not night, for at evening time there shall be light. <sup>8</sup> On that day living waters shall flow out from Jerusalem, half of them to the eastern sea and half of them to the western sea; it shall continue in summer as in winter. <sup>9</sup> And the LORD will become king over all the

earth; on that day the LORD will be one and his name one. <sup>10</sup> The whole land shall be turned into a plain from Geba to Rimmon south of Jerusalem. But Jerusalem shall remain aloft upon its site from the Gate of Benjamin to the place of the former gate, to the Corner Gate, and from the Tower of Hananel to the king's wine presses. <sup>11</sup> And it shall be inhabited, for there shall be no more curse; Jerusalem shall dwell in security.

**Psalm 50:1-6**  
*Deus deorum*

- 1      The Lord, the God of gods, has spoken; \*  
        he has called the earth from the rising of the sun to  
        its setting.
- 2      Out of Zion, perfect in its beauty, \*  
        God reveals himself in glory.
- 3      Our God will come and will not keep silence; \*  
        before him there is a consuming flame,  
        and round about him a raging storm.
- 4      He calls the heavens and the earth from above \*  
        to witness the judgment of his people.
- 5      “Gather before me my loyal followers, \*  
        those who have made a covenant with me  
        and sealed it with sacrifice.”
- 6      Let the heavens declare the rightness of his cause; \*  
        for God himself is judge.

**A Reading from 1 Thessalonians 3:6-13**

But now that Timothy has come to us from you, and has brought us the good news of your faith and love and reported that you always remember us kindly and long to see us, as we long to see you -- <sup>7</sup> for this reason, brethren, in all our distress and affliction we have been comforted about you through your faith; <sup>8</sup> for now we live, if you stand fast in the Lord. <sup>9</sup> For what thanksgiving can

we render to God for you, for all the joy which we feel for your sake before our God, <sup>10</sup> praying earnestly night and day that we may see you face to face and supply what is lacking in your faith? <sup>11</sup> Now may our God and Father himself, and our Lord Jesus, direct our way to you; <sup>12</sup> and may the Lord make you increase and abound in love to one another and to all men, as we do to you, <sup>13</sup> so that he may establish your hearts unblamable in holiness before our God and Father, at the coming of our Lord Jesus with all his saints.

### **The Holy Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ according to St. Luke 21:25-31**

"And there will be signs in sun and moon and stars, and upon the earth distress of nations in perplexity at the roaring of the sea and the waves, <sup>26</sup> men fainting with fear and with foreboding of what is coming on the world; for the powers of the heavens will be shaken. <sup>27</sup> And then they will see the Son of man coming in a cloud with power and great glory. <sup>28</sup> Now when these things begin to take place, look up and raise your heads, because your redemption is drawing near." <sup>29</sup> And he told them a parable: "Look at the fig tree, and all the trees; <sup>30</sup> as soon as they come out in leaf, you see for yourselves and know that the summer is already near. <sup>31</sup> So also, when you see these things taking place, you know that the kingdom of God is near.
