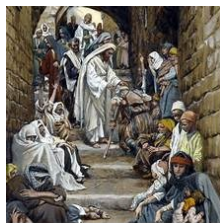
Lenten Family Night

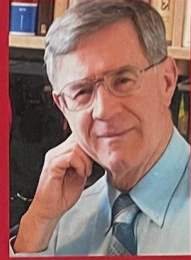
